Abstract Submission Guidelines

Students, academicians and researchers are welcome to present their research related to the theme of the seminar at the poster presentation competition. Selection for the poster presentation is based on the abstracts submitted.

Submission of Abstracts:

- All abstracts should be mailed to: abstracts.crsic@gmail.com with the title of the abstract and name of the presenting author clearly mentioned in the body of the mail.
- ➤ Abstracts should not exceed the length of **one A4 page**
- The abstracts should be structured and contain title (Top of the paper, centered, bold, all capital, Times New Roman, 14), name of authors (last name followed by initials, name of presenting author to be underlined, Times New Roman, 10), complete address of the institution including the state, country and pincode (Times New Roman, 10), Email ID of the presenting author, Key words (not more than 5, Times New Roman, 10), aims, objectives, methodology, results and discussions, conclusions, references and acknowledgements. Use of graphs, tables and figures is strongly recommended
- Leave a 1 inch margin on all 4 sides of the abstract
- > Abstracts not abiding to the above mentioned formatting guidelines will be immediately rejected and not considered for the review process
- ➤ Last date of submission of abstracts is **26**th **December, 2018**
- ➤ Intimation of acceptance will be sent by **7**th **January, 2019**
- ➤ It is mandatory for the presenting author and the corresponding author to avail CRSIC membership if not already a member (membership details enclosed).
- > The best three posters will receive cash prizes besides an **International Travel Award** for the 'First Prize' winner
