(2002-2005). After joining POSTECH in 2005, he served as a consultant for Johnson & Johnson (2008), a visiting professor at Harvard Medical School and Massachusetts General Hospital (2012-2013), at Stanford University (2019-2020), and at the University of Tokyo and ICONM (2026). He is the founder and CEO of PHI BIOMED. He received the Science and Technology Medal from the Korean President (2024), the Korean President Patent Award (2015), and several Korean Minister Awards. He was elected as the National Academy of Engineering of Korea (2020), the President of POSTECH Faculty Council (2024), the Fellow of IUSBSE (2024), the Vice President for the Polymer Society of Korea (2024) and for the Korean Society of Biomaterials (2025), and the Fellow of Korean Academy of Science and Technology (2025). He is the Editor-in-Chief of Biomaterials Research, **Executive Editor of Advanced Drug Delivery Reviews (ADDR)**, Associate Editor of Biomaterials and Heliyon, the Guest Editor of Advanced Materials, ADDR, Journal of Controlled Release and others.
