MEET THE TEAM

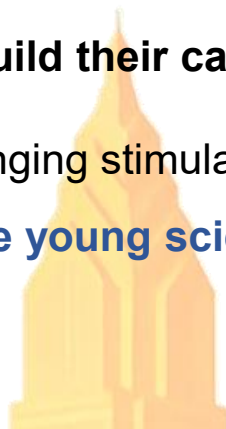

Dedicated to bringing stimulating **education workshops** and **new networking concepts** to **meet the needs of the young scientists of the Controlled Release Society.**

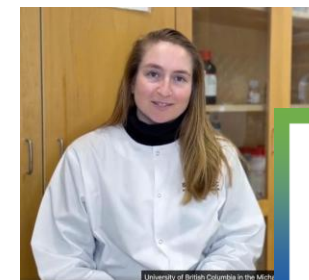
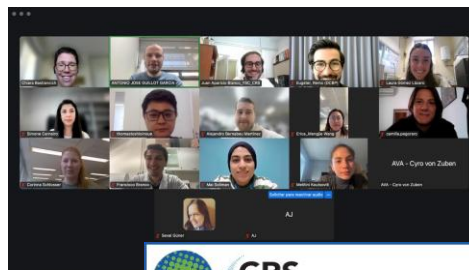




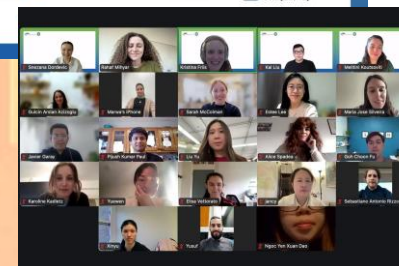
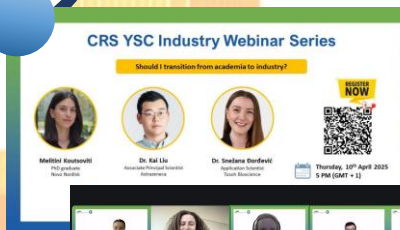
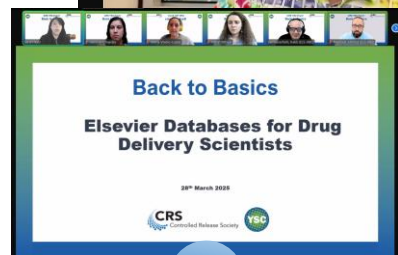
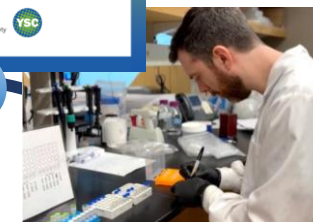
